This center is an "Early Reading First Site", has a credentialed teacher in each classroom, and is nationally accredited by NAEYC, the National Association for the Education of Young Children.

Elmwood Community School is an alternative high school that provides educational and therapeutic services for students that have not been successful in traditional school environments.

As a company that believes that education is the key to opportunity, we know that financial constraints are one of the largest barriers to obtaining a quality education.

We have set up The Robert W. Lewis Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund to help residents of Turning The Corner and students that graduate from Elmwood Community School with funds for college and/or technical school. 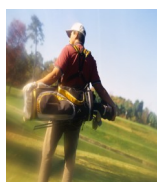
